submitted to Commission by Shepherd.

Chairman asked for Mytton's statement.

Shepherd: Statement sent by post. - he hasn't even a  
copy here. Will pass Chairman's consent  
to the right operators. assure it will be  
within an hour.

Mr. Toolson, Persand, 25 Lamaha Street Company  
director manager of Mr. Toolson Persand Ltd

Timber Depot at Christchurch usually visits depot.  
normally stays at Rockstone - point where  
top line is 21 miles west of Christchurch.

Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> visited Timber depot from Midley  
to Super via the discharge of very expensive  
machine. At 9 p.m. returned with Superintendent  
& 5 other who went to Christchurch. My Superintendent  
wanted meal, I went to Lam's hotel to make  
arrangements. One of my men (Indian) was burnt  
by acid on the way. About 5 or 6 men inside  
the restaurant. he made transportation of the men  
to hospital. About 15-20 men came in  
restaurant & threatened to beat us up. Crowd  
increased (very hostile) started to stone  
place. We approached with toy guns <sup>plumbers</sup> ~~travellers~~

16-8<sup>th</sup> (by wife) Amid the confusion I managed to escape.  
escaped & returned to Georgetown next  
day. My foreman advised me to go into  
jungle or leave right away. he said  
trip will be happening seriously - he  
meant it would not be safe for Indians to  
be there. I did not tell about this to  
anyone in Georgetown. I arrived midday Sunday  
in Georgetown. No report made to P.O. by  
less - on 25<sup>th</sup> July. I was told by Bangtan

at 1000 gallons of duty free gasoline, Office bond.  
 \$1,000 financial loss. Foreman. Durant - African.  
 When I left Wisner I saw a fire on  
 Friday - workmen said it was 3rd or 4th  
 floor in the last few days. I can  
 recognize the leader of gang if I saw him  
 perhaps he was drinking. Butters told  
 me the next day he had a scuffle with  
 the men - I went on Friday by plane  
 "David Et Marine" name of man burnt with  
 acid. I thought they were trying to  
 I had a chat with Mr. Carl Austin at  
 1:pm on Sunday. & told him about situation  
 in Wisner. I did not report officially.

Banga Mary was the leader of gang.  
 I reported about man who was burnt  
 by acid to police at Wisner. I did  
 not recognize Banga Mary but was told he  
 was Banga Mary. Durant had lived in  
 Wisner for 20 yrs he did not recognize  
 any one of them.

George Woolford Buxton E. C. Dem. I work  
 with P. P. P. now. Wisner. Killam Operator at  
 Demba for over 23 yrs. My living quarters  
 burnt on 27th May (night) P. P. P. Candidate  
 for Upper Dem river 1961. Yes there was  
 tension - about 2 weeks before that P. Y. O.  
 came to Wisner to poison water. Several  
 people asked me. I said I have no knowledge  
 of that. I asked police Butters tried to get  
 to find out Police statement later on said  
 man was false. ~~Saturday~~ Sunday 5. am.  
 (24th May) land explosion in 3rd ally - a house  
 on fire. It was Akit's house, but Hikit was  
 (negro)

- I did not make any effort to contact the police when I saw fines on Sunday night. I did not leave because our house would have been burnt. Mr. P.Y.O. equally believed w. P.Y.O. not responsible for atrocities elsewhere in '63. remembers that P.Y.O. was going to burn Boro-site co. people waited for hours, h/4 night with sticks & bottles.
- w. '63. I was leader at Wismer. P.Y.O. is used as boogymen to create tension to create disturbance.

on Monday I did meet many strangers (under 25) white slight black parts. - 2 groups - 20-25 in each group.

Daphne Lythrop, Pearly Lester, Glen, Stanley Rose, Walcutt & other people whom I don't know. I live at Wismer.

I saw Banga Mary on Thursday 21st I met him at her King's Shop Wismer. About 2 weeks before he told me why this happened in Wismer (I was at 1st alley). I did not believe him. "Let me tell you, you know what going to happen all you P.P. he caught my bicycle. P.C. Brown (McKenzie) would find what happened. Br. Chapman B. Mary." P.C. Brown said if I was there when you were beaten they would come to beat me too. I did not see beating or looting.

I heard about Sealy disturbance about 4 days before disturbance.

I did hear threats before trouble Banga Mary, There were rumours of Mr. Jordan's visit & what he said. I made a report to Mrs. Jagan. Lost about \$3,500 in fine.

they are burning & looting - they are strangers  
they may not know you "Man you too  
stray head" a woman said I stayed  
at 8.30 a.m. at Makengie. Next  
day some people said ("Tuesdy") Woolford  
you must stand clear you fail to  
see what you're doing with E. Indians  
for your own safety keep to M. That  
evening while going back to my sister's house  
a group of women near school said  
Woolford keep you self safe. On Wednesday  
at 9 o'clock. I rang SSS, police in  
Wisner. I got Mr. Hobbs on phone. I said  
I need protection to go to my house to  
get my papers." He said he had  
no police. Call later. 11.30 Hobbs  
said there's no police. Mr. Hobbs came  
over & told me we can offer you  
no protection. I saw manager of Denba.  
he told me to take my annual  
leave. I came away by R.H. Carr at  
6.30 p.m. I haven't been since then.

the house was burnt down.

Lily Sreenandan - Cambridge - School  
teacher. - attached to Christchurch Joint School.  
32 on staff. - 3 Indians (Akbar, Soosankar (ag head  
teacher + myself) Target since January.

Monday since I went there, there was long on. Five  
a month before 25<sup>th</sup> May. Thursday 1 fire  
Friday 2 houses burnt. I heard explosion Friday  
night. Saturday night 2 fires by 1st alley  
Sunday several houses a fire around 1 mile  
& further down. I was living in Silver City  
I went to school on Monday at 8.30 a.m.  
I saw parents coming in for children (both  
Africans + Indians) one of parents told me  
there was riot in direction of his house.

Later I learnt they were beating Indians  
valley of the road. I saw Akbar when had

a man who came for his child +  
said they had burnt his house +  
killed his brother. Head teacher advised

Richard Khan is to dismiss school. The African teachers  
went away the 3 Indian teachers were left

in building. I saw the D. Commissioner passing  
I clapped to him he came & told  
him what happened - he said he  
was going to telephone for jeep to get

is. Mr. Allen Kip (overseer) came he  
said she must not go out because  
they were beating Indians he  
suggested I go through back to Saturday  
& stay there - He said he was sorry  
he cannot labour against as he was

warned. As I was going back. When  
 took a fat cable so & so she finally  
 take so & so I ran up stairs. The crowd  
 came in yard & started to help. Come  
 down we went to show you the Apu that.  
 Two boys trying to climb up. I hid in  
 toilet. I became to head mistress. (Mrs Bank Craft)  
 she tried dissuade crowd she followed crowd  
 Benda passing we called to her she asked  
 "did jeep come for you" we said no &  
 she said she is going to telephone again.  
 Mr. Bank craft went away no jeep came.  
 till 2 p.m. Benda had telephoned Danta  
 & speed boat was coming for us. Mr. Benda  
 & 3 other men saw us off a while after  
 & took us to Mackenzie. we passed  
 church the Father Pink. told officer to take  
 us to his house. (4 p.m.) we stayed there  
 till 7 p.m.

I was living with friends - colored. they were  
 warned - he hinted since (Monday<sup>18<sup>th</sup></sup>) he actual  
 told me on Friday. I asked <sup>Henshaw</sup> Paul  
 if he could let me stay there in Saturday.  
 on Sunday I left my bag. I decided to  
 stay from Monday night. I lost about  
 \$500 Jewellery & clothy. I heard on Monday  
 11<sup>th</sup> & heard people said "we preparing  
 for C.R. day & they going to have some  
 fun."

Karwall Persaud. 73, Seaford St Cambridge  
 Stall holder at Border Market 145 B-1 over bar  
 witness & lived with my father (Tibiana Persaud)  
 name: Sheila Persaud. had stall in market  
 Karwall Persaud. Sister. on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> night

I saw fires in Chesham area from 7 p.m. to 11.30.

I went to bed part of the night. kept waked till

2 a.m. I got up about 5.30 25 May I went to my stall. At about 8 p.m. a crowd (60)

rushed into market & beaty stall holders.

I saw John Leason. beaty, kind (Indian).

The crowd surrounded me but did not notice

a man "How you selling these eggs." I say

10 cents he picked up 2 trays 60 each

& said "I want these." & took the eggs

without paying. I closed up lower yard,

I left for home. (1/4 mile away) I went home

my father's shop closed, we went up stairs

Saw crowd pelty Bisco's shop. I saw

several fires in different directions. Crowds

in front of our house - about 2 p.m. (300

people men women & children) two of them

x had Barbons of Barbo beer, even

& pelted the change with empty bottles

& went away. I saw more fires.

close to our house at 5 p.m. the

crowd came back to our house. One

one came on top of sled & peeped

through window. He shouted to crowd

"They are inside" He went to Mrs Bacch's

yard. My brother looked through back

door & saw the man. I asked "What do

you want?" I'll give you what you want

& leave us alone." He said come

out side & go to station. I asked

why is funny to take us to station?"

"the Vol. will take you." I asked

where are the volunteers? He was breaking

the paley & enter our yard. The front

door was broken. I went down &  
 secured the back door. I smelt smoke.  
 The man who was breaking the par, came  
 up lunch steps broke door with iron  
 bar - came into house with other people.  
 Started to demand money & jewelry. Took  
 my money & jewelry searched everyone of us. Another  
 man with cutlass bent over with boards in  
 the house was burning by then. I slipped  
 my parents & wife & sister <sup>nicie</sup> through back  
 door. I passed them into Mrs Clerk's yard.  
 The man continued to beat me to  
 the front of the house - "where is the  
 money? we want money. Come back  
 he was still beating me he forced me  
 back up the stairs & then down, I  
 managed to escape into Clerk's yard.  
 The man who broke open the door  
 with iron bar shouted to my parents  
 to hide in toilet. I took my parents out  
 of toilet into back street my wife & sister  
 & nicie went to Mrs Clerk's house  
 from the back street with my parents. I  
 decided to look for my wife & sister &  
 nicie. I walked around my cross street  
 to front of our house & saw a very  
 large crowd down by the river side  
 Kuamika. I asked "If he saw my  
 wife or sister but "Hu" he went  
 away, I went into the crowd, I <sup>saw</sup> ~~found~~  
 my wife & sister being assaulted  
 kicked & raped. I was standing in the  
 river. (2 feet in water) a woman "Is not  
 her husband that?" & the crowd surrounded  
 me, two fellows cuffed me on the face.

I managed to escape into the river with my wife 'Stracy' came with a small craft (mild steel) & rescued me & my wife. My sister was also swimming with us a man swam at & took her back. One James Molahis a McKeegan with his outboard motor took us to McKeegan's hospital, I spent Monday in hospital with my wife. She came in the hospital about 1 day later. My niece was in the hospital too. Next morning we left for Georgetown & met my parents & brothers on the boat M.V. Basima. Three weeks later I went back.

I had police & Galdier protection went alone & found some of my Mother's jewels & spent the night at station. \$5,500 - still still there. (I am not paying for it. I made a report to police at Brickdam - [Bayer King, Mary King, Patrick King] crowd that looted. Censor & Weber looted. Clott.

Lived in W.S.W. 19 yrs. The 2 men who were rapy were Stripes. Niece Dorcas Cookman. Kenneth Hodges kicked by wife. I don't know how many of men who took \$5000 back (stranger) J. Censor. Capped Enid in Market.

Niece about 15 yrs. - assaulted by crowd.

 Monday after the men have gone to work.  
 Harris said the stuff is already ~~distributed~~  
 distributed. R. Jordan said OKI operation

 my purchase + ~~to~~ <sup>was</sup> home. I heard  
 land explosion on 24<sup>th</sup> 8.3 p.m. I did  
 not come out. I was awake in fever. Next  
 morning 25<sup>th</sup> I went to work. I passed

 8 a.m. I noticed several buildings  
 on fire in the street. I left work at  
 11 a.m. crossed over to my shop. I saw  
 my Landlord John Hoops. He told  
 me to remove as there were some  
 people that night - I asked him to give  
 me a drop line. A voice shouted  
 "John John Butcher Jack on a bicycle"  
 John put down the man. "John put down the  
 man" John said I am taking him  
 to remove he is doing a very large  
 he stayed me with bicycle in front  
 of crowd. I was surrounded. Joyce  
 Bucher hit my gear, bent me home  
 my pants - Jack hit me with long  
 flexible object. My wife had bitecase  
 pushed - I told her we couldn't leave  
 the crowd was - the ywa. I passed

her to next door neighbors. Through letter work  
 the child too. I ~~covered~~ covered window  
 with bed sheet. I hid under bed. ~~One~~  
 I heard several voices, demanded, me  
 to come out, they then broke  
 open & came in. "Man like he put  
 notes said "Look he underneath the  
 bed. As I crawled out, a negro cut  
 me 2 cuts on my left arm. I  
 reached door hit me with 4x4  
 which caused me fall. I can recognize  
 man who hit me lives under Bruce's house.  
 Jackson continued hitting me & ran &  
 escaped. I could not jump. Bruce  
 took & about 25 others hit me on my  
 head & fell apart. Several other  
 blows on my head & body. I must  
 have been unconscious. I was taken

We were taken to station. Landed in Mac. Rent. - take to Mack. Police Station Cuttack. Const. Personnel Nable, Moffet, went to Mack. Police Station. till about 7. p.m. I assisted in taking over about 5,000 evacuees to Trade School. They departed with Mr. Saldern to patrol Mackay area. I patrolled from 12 midnight. - fines at station. we assisted in taking evacuees to Sports Club & Trade School. Station & patrol duties at Mackay I was detailed - normal police duties.

I was not threatened or abused no complaints for evacuees. about police. - I heard people say police were not taking proper action they felt we should shoot the people I was at Ichuni before Smith's house.

Nov 63 - moved or April 64.

Const. David Mangroo 6047. Kitty. 25<sup>th</sup> May, Mackay for duty at Mac. Police Station detailed by Supt. Hobs - ethnic disturbance & all Indians must be detailed at station

no complaint from Evanes
