Statement by Comrade Janet Jagan

There is now in circula-
tion a letter purporting to
be sent by me from the
People's Progressive Party
on PPP letter-heads and
with a copy of my signa-
ture. This letter has a
document in the form of a
letter attached, which is
unsigned, and which asks
the Party to issue a "con-
fidential directive warning
all members not to par-
ticipate in ceremonies or
m o v e m e n t s supporting
Gandhism or which uses
his name".

The letter is a forgery
and does not come from
the People's Progressive
Party. It brings to mind
other forgeries and false
documents which have
been issued in the name of
the PPP. Just prior to the
last elections, one of the
daily newspapers publish-
ed a false document under
similar conditions, that is,

a letter bearing a replica
Party of my signature and
using letterheads of the
People's Progressive Party.

The authors of this for-
gery are evidently not
fully familiar with Party
procedures and have made
the mistake of sending
such letters through the
Post to persons whom I
see daily at Freedom House
It is common knowledge at
Freedom House that all
letters to persons working
there are delivered by
hand on the premises.

There are subversive
elements in the commu-
nity which seek by one
means or another to dis-
rupt the PPP and to dis-
credit it. This new docu-
ment is another attempt.

I have reported this
matter to the Police and
trust that they will make
efforts to apprehend the
persons who are guilty of
this mischief.
